RSA Carbon*Limited* is exploring the idea for personal carbon trading. Conceived as an emissions trading scheme in which individuals become carbon traders, expanding existing schemes to cover all of the UK's emissions, personal carbon trading could bring about rapid societal shift in favour of a low carbon society as individuals and households make decisions in favour of low carbon living to better manage their carbon footprint.

18 months into the project, Carbon*Limited* has developed alternative approaches to making this idea a reality and is ready to consult with RSA fellows and the wider public. The Carbon*Limited* team will be giving you a personal carbon allowance and asking 'how will you use yours?'

Café RSA is a popular forum for debating current issues and promoting public engagement, a collaboration between the RSA and Living East. Events take place in an informal café-setting with topical presentations and lively audience participation.
